The Board of Directors of the Dufferin Community Foundation has authorized the release of another \$30,000 to support mental health and well-being in Dufferin.

For this set of emergency grants, we will review applications from those organizations who offer programs and services to address mental health and well-being vulnerabilities in Dufferin County. Successful applicants will demonstrate that a newly planned or modified existing program will address the issues growing out of the COVID-19 emergency.

2021 Grant Application

This application includes two stages in the grant submission process:

Stage 1: About your Organization [Deadline - February 28, 2021]

This stage of the process begins your 2021 Grants dialogue with the Dufferin Community Foundation. The information you provide will enable us to help you qualify as an eligible applicant.

- a. Your mission and the population you serve in Dufferin
- b. Contacts information
- c. Your charitable status

As soon as you have submitted Part 1 for review, you will be contacted to discuss next steps.

Stage 2: Your Approach to Addressing Mental Health and Well-Being [Deadline – March 18, 2021]

This second stage enables you to provide a description of a new project/ program or one you already offer in your organization to address mental health and well-being among the population you serve in Dufferin.
