Overview:

Dufferin Community Foundation's 2024 Arts & Culture Grants will provide funding to organizations that advance appreciation and awareness of the arts, community heritage and cultural traditions taking place within Dufferin County. The grants may be used for initiatives like programs, projects, public performances, forums and/or events.

We are offering grants of \$2,000 in 2024.

Deadline for Applications:

Monday, October 7, 2024 at 5:00pm ET

Application Guidelines:

- Project proposals must clearly indicate how the initiative will benefit the residents of Dufferin County.
- Funds can be used for an existing project or a new project
- The funding will be used within one year of the grant being awarded.
- The program will provide demonstrable evidence of effectiveness.
- Applicants are encouraged to collaborate with other community organizations where possible.
- Upon completion, a report showing the results must be submitted to Dufferin Community Foundation.

General Eligibility:

The following eligibility requirements apply to all Dufferin Community Foundation granting programs.

- Applicant organizations must be a [qualified donee](#) (e.g. a charity registered with Canada Revenue Agency, a municipality, etc.) **OR** be partnered with one. To determine whether you are eligible, [please visit the Eligibility page on our website](#).

- The applicant must have a strong community presence in Dufferin County, with a local office or committee, or offer a program that directly benefits residents of [Dufferin County](#).
